

GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION (GDPR)

The **GDPR** is a new law (effective from 25th May 2018) which determines how your personal data is processed and kept safe.

This means we need explicit consent from you in relation to use of your contact details (as an example) and how we use them.

This means we may have to ask you for consent again.

Your Summary Care Record (SCR) is part of your medical record which we ask for your consent to share with other healthcare providers to ensure they can give you best and safest advice. For example, when you use the weekend Nurse or GP service. You will need to respond with either, '**I consent to share my SCR**' or '**I do not consent to share my SCR**'
